Water and Power Employees' Retirement Plan Board of Administration List of Acceptable Documents as Proofs of Date of Birth

Effective June 18, 2015

Original or certified copy of the unexpired document must be presented.

Documents issued in a foreign language must be notarized by a certified translator.

Documents presented must contain the name and date of birth.

Class I

Any one of the following documents is acceptable as proof of date of birth:

- Birth Certificate
- U.S. Passport
- U.S. Passport Card
- Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt Card
- U.S. Naturalization Certificate

OR

Class II

Any three or more of the Class II documents listed below will be accepted in lieu of a Class I document. At least one document must include a photograph.

- State-issued driver's license or ID card
- Other U.S. government-issued ID (federal or local)
- U.S. military card or military discharge papers (DD 214)
- Native American Tribal document
- School- issued ID with a photograph
- Marriage certificate or license
- Baptismal certificate or church record (must have detailed info)
- Insurance policies
- Employment records
- Notarized affidavits by parents or relatives
- School Records, if under 18 years old
- Doctor, clinic or hospital records, if under 18 years old
