Public Comments

No public comments were received.

1. Update on the Plan's Exposure to Sudan

Mr. Wolfson provided the background for this update on the Plan's investment exposure to Sudan. He reported that as of September 30, 2010, the Plan's exposure to companies labeled as Highest Offenders by the Conflict Risk Network was unchanged from the previous update and remained at approximately \$3.42 million. He stated all of the Highest Offender exposure continued to be solely from the Retirement Fund's commingled emerging market equity account with The Boston Company (TBC).

He reported the Plan's exposure to companies labeled as Ongoing Engagement decreased since the previous update and was approximately \$5.3 million. He stated the Ongoing exposure was due to the Plan's commingled emerging market equity account with TBC and the Plan's separate international developed value account with TBC.

Mr. Wolfson stated Staff will continue to send letters to the Ongoing Engagement companies to encourage divestiture of all holdings in Sudan and will continue to monitor the Plan's exposure and provide updates to the Board.
